HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 703, L.D. 1928,
Bill, "AN ACT to Reform the Maine Workers' Compensation Act to Assure Coverage for Maine Workers."

Amend the bill in section 30, in that part designated "§55-B." in the first paragraph, in the 2nd line from the end (page 21, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "400 weeks" and inserting in its place the following: '855 weeks'

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 The purpose of this amendment is to make the cut 17 off of disability benefits for permanently partially 18 disabled people consistent with the practice of the 19 New England region. The New England average period 20 allowed duration for partial disability benefits is 21 855 weeks.
