Included in the study shall be the anticipated costs of each of these systems and the anticipated overall savings which will result from implementation of each of these systems. The commission shall also identify what implications the implementation of each of these systems in the State will have on workplace safety, on rehiring, retraining and rehabilitation and the workers' compensation system as a whole. The commission shall make its report, including any necessary implementing legislation, to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature no later than January 29, 1988.'
