Amend the amendment by inserting after section 53
12 the following:

'Sec. 53-A. Feasibility study; early interven-
14 tion; case management. The Workers' Compensation
15 Commission shall study the feasibility of implement-
16 ing early intervention and case management systems in
17 State Government. Included in the study shall be the
18 anticipated costs of each of these systems and the
19 anticipated overall savings which will result from
20 implementation of each of these systems. The commis-
21 sion shall also identify what implications the imple-
22 mentation of each of these systems in the State will
23 have on workplace safety, on rehiring, retraining and
24 rehabilitation and the workers' compensation system
25 as a whole. The commission shall make its report,
26 including any necessary implementing legislation, to
27 the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature
28 no later than January 29, 1988.'
