AN ACT Related to the Numbers Pool in the
Tri-State Lotto.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §409, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 732, §1, is amended to read:

A. The type of lottery to be conducted, except that the game shall have no more than 36 numbers from which 6 are to be selected;

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect when New Hampshire and Vermont have enacted con-

1 current legislation which limits the numbers in the
2 Tri-State Lotto game to no more than 36.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This new draft has the same purpose as the origi-
5 nal bill.

6 The title is changed to correct a technical er-
7 ror.

8 A different paragraph of the Tri-State Lotto laws
9 is amended to more accurately reflect the fact that
10 the type of lottery is not to be changed to a pool
11 bigger than 36 numbers from which 6 numbers are
12 picked.

13 The new draft also adds an effective date clause
14 which ties the effective date of this Act to the en-
15 actment of legislation achieving the same purpose by
16 the other 2 states in the Tri-State Lotto Compact,
17 Vermont and New Hampshire.
