9 violation of section 7801, subsection 9 is a Class C

2 STATEMENT OF FACT

3 Increased marine traffic has brought with it
4 increased problems with pilots operating while
5 intoxicated. This bill increases the penalties for
6 violation of the boating OUI laws from a Class E crime
7 to a Class C crime.

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
