- 8 2. Stopping. The operator of a vehicle on a way or on school property, upon meeting or overtaking a

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- school bus from either direction which has stopped, 2 with its red lights flashing, on the way to receive or discharge school children passengers, shall stop the vehicle before reaching the school bus and the operator shall not proceed until the school bus 3 4 5 6 resumes motion or until signaled by the school bus 7 operator to proceed.

- 10 Use of flashing red lights restricted. 11 bus operator shall not use the system of 12 flashing lights on a school bus for any purpose other 13
