STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that state allocation payments for special education, vocational 13 14 education, school transportation and school 15 debt service shall be broken down by category to indicate the amount paid to a local unit in each of those categories. Local units shall spend that money in the 16 17 18 same category unless the school board specifically 19 20 authorizes a different expenditure.
