Those decisions or abstracts of 15 decisions shall be available for public access.' 16 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that decisions of the Public Utilities Commission, Consumer Assistance 17 18 19 Division which are publicly accessible shall be prepared in a way that does not disclose confidential 20 21 customer information. It also changes the requirement 22 of disclosure of customer information to the utility or agency involved to narrow the range of information that must be provided to that which is pertinent to 23 24 25 the complaint.
