AN ACT to Clarify the Status of Meetings and Records of the Public Utilities Commission Under the Freedom of Access Law.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §108, as enacted by PL 1987, 8 c. 141, Pt. A, §6, is amended to read:

§108. Commission action; quorum; notice

A majority of the duly appointed commissioners shall constitute a quorum and the act or decision of a 1 2 majority of commissioners present, if at least a 3 · quorum is present, shall be the act or decision of the 4 5 commission in any formal proceeding before the 6 commission. Notwithstanding Title 1, section 406, the commission is required to give notice of public 7 8 9 proceedings only if the commission will deal with the expenditure of public funds or taxation or will adopt 10 policy at the meeting. 11 12 35-A MRSA §704, sub-§5 is enacted to Sec. 2. 13 read: 14 Confidentiality of customer information. 5. C. Compilations of information in which the customer's identity is not disclosed are not confidential.

STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to reinstate, for the Public Utilities Commission only, the criteria that notice of meetings must be given only if the Public Utilities Commission will adopt policy or deal with the expenditure of public funds or taxation, which 8 9 10 11 criteria were deleted from the freedom of access law 12 in 13 the First Regular Session of the 113th The burden on the 14 Legislature. Public Utilities Commission of the deletion may have been unanticipated 15 16 because of the Public Utilities Commission uniqueness 17 as both a full-time and multimember body. The bill also clarifies the confidential nature of customer records received or produced by the commission. 18 19
