4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §1, sub-§15-C, as enacted by PL 1967, c. 245, §5, is amended to read: 7

15-C. Street or highway. "Street" or "highway"

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1 shall mean the entire width between boundary lines of 2 every way publicly maintained when any part thereof 3 is open to the use of the public for purposes of 4 vehicular traffic.

5 Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §1, sub-§21 is amended to read:

6 <u>21. Way.</u> "Way" shall include all kinds of public 7 ways and public easements.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

9 The purpose of this bill is to include public 10 easements under the definition of "streets" and 11 "ways". This allows the Department of Transportation 12 to work with towns to regulate speeds on discontinued 13 town ways on which public easements have been retained.

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
