7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 729, L.D. 1988,
8 Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Powers of the Maine
9 Youth Center Employees."

10 Amend the Bill by inserting after the title the
11 following:

12 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the
13 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days
14 after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

15 Whereas, the authority provided by this bill is
16 necessary to help preserve the public peace; and

17 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
18 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
19 Constitution of Maine and require the following
20 legislation as immediately necessary for the
21 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;
22 now, therefore,'

23 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
24 before the statement of fact the following:

25 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
26 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when
27 approved.'
