10 Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2
11 and inserting in its place the following:

12 'Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §8003, sub-§5, ¶A, as enacted
13 by PL 1985, c. 748, §18, is amended to read:

14 A. Suspend a violator's license for up to 90
15 days, or impose a civil penalty of up to \$500,
16 or both, for any violation of the applicable laws,
17 rules or license terms under its jurisdiction; or'

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 This amendment makes it clear that the regulatory
20 power of the boards within the Department of
21 Professional and Financial Regulation includes the
22 power to assess a fine or suspend a license or both
23 assess a fine and suspend a license.
