IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Bring the Computer Services Section of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation into the Division of Administrative Services.

6 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 7 follows:

8 Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §8003, sub-§1, as amended by PL 9 1985, c. 785, Pt. B, §55, is further amended to read:

1 Division of Administrative Services. There is 1. created a Division of Administrative Services, which 2 shall constitute a division within the department, to provide assistance to the commissioner and to the 3 4 5 agencies within the department in personnel civil 6 service matters, budgeting and financial matters, purchasing, and clerical and support services, and to perform such other duties as the commissioner may 7 8 9 designate. The commissioner may employ a Director of 10 Administrative Services and such clerical and technical assistants as are necessary to discharge the duties of the division, and shall outline their duties 11 12 13 and fix their compensation, subject to the Civil 14 Service Law.

15 Within the Division of Administrative Α. shall be a computer services 16 Services, there section. It shall be the responsibility of the computer services section to process and issue original and renewal licenses for the department 17 18 19 20 and for those bureaus, boards and commissions 21 within the department as the commissioner direct. The licenses shall be processed may 22 and 23 issued only upon authorization of the appropriate bureau, board or commission, or upon the authorization of the commissioner in the case of 24 25 those licenses granted directly by the department. The computer services section shall 26 27 28 maintain a central register containing the name and address of each person or firm licensed by profession, occupation or industry and such other 29 30 information as the commissioner may direct for 31 32 administration, information or planning purposes. The commissioner, with the advice of the respective bureaus, boards and commissions, may determine the type and form of licenses issued by 33 34 35 all agencies within the department. The computer services section shall perform such other 36 37 administrative services for the agencies 38 within 39 the department as the commissioner may direct.
