1 2	AN ACT to Clarify the Hazardous Waste Lien Law.
3 4	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
5 6 7	38 MRSA \$1371, sub-\$2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 419, \$14, and as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 540, is amended to read: Page 1-LR4285

1 Any lien filed pursuant to this section on Α. 2 real estate which encompasses an uncontrolled 3 site shall have precedence hazardous substance 4 over all encumbrances on the real estate recorded 5 section. after the effective date of this The term, "real estate" in this paragraph includes all 6 7 real estate of a responsible party which has been 8 the property description included ±n of the 9 affected real estate within the 3-year period 10 preceding the date of filing of the lien or on or 11 effective of this sectionafter the date 12 whichever-period-is-shorter-

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill removes the so-called "3-year look-back" 15 provision from the new superlien law. The provision 16 penalized bona fide innocent purchasers of subdivided 17 property who had no responsibility for the existence 18 of hazardous wastes on the property.

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
