COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1483, L.D. 2017,  
Bill, "AN ACT Requiring that Curb Ramps be Constructed  
in Accordance with the American National Standards  
Institute Standards."

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of  
the first line after the enacting clause, (page 1,  
line 7 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated  
"§706." in subsection 1, in the 5th and 6th lines from  
the end (page 2, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.) by striking  
out the following: "These standards shall be adopted"  
and inserting in its place the following: 'Prior to  
October 1, 1988, these standards shall be adopted in a  
form'

Further amend the bill in that part designated  
"§706." by striking out all of subsections 2 and 3 and  
inserting in their place the following:

'2. Application. Standards set for curb ramping  
under subsection 1 shall not apply to any existing  
curb on October 3, 1973; but shall apply, to the  
extent reasonable, to all new curb construction and to  
all replacement curbs constructed in order to allow  
reasonable access to crosswalks after that date and  
prior to October 1, 1988, and shall apply to any new  
construction or reconstruction commenced after October  
1, 1988.
