AN ACT to Prohibit the Sale of the Substance Amyl Nitrite, Commonly Referred to as "Rush" or "Lockerroom," to Minors.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

22 MRSA §2213-A is enacted to read:

8 §2213-A. Sale of amyl nitrite to minors prohibited

1. Prohibition. No person may sell amyl nitrite, commonly referred to as "rush" or "lockerroom," to 1 2 3 minors. 2. Violation. Any person who violates subsection 1 commits a Class D crime. 4 5 6 STATEMENT OF FACT 7 This bill makes it a Class D crime for any person 8 to sell amyl nitrite to minors. 9 Amyl nitrite, often called "rush" or "lockerroom," is now being used as a "recreational drug" which 10 enters the blood quickly and lowers a person's blood pressure rapidly. This creates a dizzy or fainting sensation and is being used as a recreational drug by 11 12 13 minors. It has unhealthful side effects, including 14 nosebleeds and headaches. 15
