- AN ACT to Repeal the Sales Tax Exemption on
  Self-Help Literature on Alcoholism.

- 4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 6 36 MRSA \$1760, sub-\$57, as enacted by PL 1987, 7 c. 343, \$5, is repealed.

2	The purpose of this bill is to repeal the
3	provision which provided a sales tax exemption on the
4	sale of self-help literature on alcoholism. The
5	exemption was intended to be available only to
6	Alcoholics Anonymous groups; however, as written, the
7	exemption is available to a broad variety of groups
8	which may not espouse the principles and traditions of
9	Alcoholics Anonymous. Repeal of this exemption will
10	not impose a hardship on Alcoholics Anonymous groups
11	since the material is available from the General
12	Service Office on a tax-free basis.

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
