COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 1497, L.D. 2047,
Bill, "AN ACT to Require Gasoline Stations which
Provide Self-Service at a Lower Rate to Provide
Services at the Same Rate for Handicapped Drivers."

Amend the bill by striking out all of that part
designated "§1661-A." and inserting in its place the
following:

'§1661-A. Gasoline stations to provide services for
handicapped drivers

Every full-service gasoline station offering
self-service pumping at a lesser cost shall require an
attendant employed by the station to dispense gasoline
to any motor vehicle properly displaying a handicapped
placard or special designating plates issued under
Title 29, section 252, when the person to whom the
placard or plates have been issued is the operator of
the vehicle, the service is requested, the operator
has a drivers license designated with a code H,
restricted to special equipment, and there is no
nonhandicapped adult in the motor vehicle.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment restricts the application of the
bill to handicapped drivers who require special
equipment in order to drive a car and to situations

1 where there is no nonhandicapped adult in the car. It
2 also eliminates unnecessary provisions to pump the gas
3 from self-service pumps and to display the provisions
4 of the law on every gas pump.
