4	housing containing 20 or more units, shall comply with
5	the standards of construction and shall also conform

7	A. No less than 20% of the ground level units

7 A. No less than 20% of the ground level units
8 shall be accessible to and usable by physically
9 handicapped persons.
0 B. A minimum of 10% of the upper story units

B. A minimum of 10% of the upper story units connected by an elevator, as provided in section 2702, subsection 6, shall be accessible to and usable by handicapped persons.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill seeks to increase the number of public housing units that are handicapped accessible. As the handicapped become more mobile and visible in society, housing needs are going to increase. These changes will make more units available to them.
