AN ACT to Allow Greater Departmental Input Under Certificate of Need Provisions.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, certain health care facilities have experienced unnecessary costs and delays through the

- 18 Sec. 2. 22 MRSA § 304-E is enacted to read:
- 19 §304-E. Waiver of certificate of need review when 20 review is unnecessary and serves no public 21 purpose
- 1. Application for waiver. A health care facility may apply for a waiver of the certificate of 22 23 need review requirements otherwise imposed by this 24 chapter. The department shall establish, by rule 25
- promulgated in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, 26 27
- 28 procedures for reviewing the waiver request.
- 29 2. Criteria for waiver. The department shall waive the certificate of need review for any project 30 31 for which a request for waiver under subsection 1 has

- been received in all cases where the waiver request demonstrates that the certificate of need review is 33 34 unnecessary and would serve no public purpose.
