STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Amend the Solid Waste Provisions of the Site Location Law.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §484, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1971, c. 613, §5, is further amended to read:

1. Financial capacity. The developer has the

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financial capacity and technical ability to meet state air and water pollution control standards, and has made adequate provision for solid waste disposal, the control of offensive odors, and the securing and maintenance of sufficient and healthful water supplies.

6	A. The board shall find that the developer has
7	made adequate provision for solid waste disposal
8	when, in addition to any other conditions the
9	board finds necessary, the solid waste disposal
10	facility proposed for receipt of the waste is in
11	compliance with state law or is municipally owned;

12 Sec. 2. Application. This Act shall apply to 13 all permits previously issued under this article to 14 which the board has attached conditions precluding the 15 use of municipally owned solid waste disposal 16 facilities.
