17 18	'Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 31 32 33	Sec. 1. Commission created; duties. There is established the Commission on Manufactured Housing to examine issues affecting manufactured housing, including mobile home parks and mobile home owners. Among the issues to be examined are: Unreasonable rent increases; the eviction process for removing tenants of mobile home parks; unreasonable rules; unreasonable fees or charges; conduct of real estate agents in the sale of mobile homes; tenants' rights of first refusal when the park is for sale; protection of tenants' organizations; prohibiting the importation of pre-1976 mobile homes into the State or municipalities; the safety of mobile homes; the role manufactured housing plays in providing affordable housing; zoning for mobile homes and mobile home parks, especially as it relates to older mobile homes;

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municipal regulation of mobile home parks; and any other issues which affect the health, safety and continued viability of mobile home owners, mobile home parks and manufactured housing in general. The commission shall consult with the Maine State Housing Authority and the Manufactured Housing Board which shall provide information and assistance.

8 Sec. 2. Commission membership. The commission 9 consist of 13 members to be appointed 10 Two members of the Joint Standing Committee follows: 11 on Legal Affairs, one to be appointed by the Speaker 12 of the House and one to be appointed by the President 13 of the Senate; 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation, one to be appointed 14 15 by the Speaker of the House and one to be appointed by the President of the Senate; 2 members of the Joint 16 Standing Committee on State and Local Government, one 17 18 to be appointed by the Speaker of the House and one to appointed by the President of the Senate; 2 19 representatives of mobile home 20 park owners 21 operators, one to be appointed by the Speaker of the House and one to be appointed by the President of the Senate; 2 representatives of mobile home owners, one 22 23 24 to be appointed by the Speaker of the House and one to 25 be appointed by the President of the Senate; one representative of manufacturers and retail dealers 26 27 from the Manufactured House Association of Maine, to 28 be appointed by that organization; one representative 29 Maine Building Officials and Inspectors 30 Association to be appointed by that organization; and one representative of the Municipal Association to be 31 32 appointed by that organization. The appointing authorities shall make the required appointments by September 1, 1988 and shall notify the Executive 33 34 35 the Legislative Council when Director οf 36 appointments have been made.

37 **Sec. 3. Commission compensation.** The 38 commission members shall be compensated for expenses only.

Sec. 4. Commission schedule; meetings; staff. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall convene the first meeting of the commission no later than October 1, 1988. The commission shall
