IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Require Dealers in All-Terrain Vehicles to Provide Written Warranties.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

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12 MRSA §7855, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

7 <u>6. Warranties and information on used ATV's. Any</u> 8 dealer who offers a warranty in connection with the

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1	sale or transfer of a used ATV shall furnish a written
2	statement concerning that warranty. The statement
3	regarding the warranty shall indicate the parts or
4	systems of the vehicle that are covered and those not
5	covered by the warranty and what the dealer will do in
6	the event of a defect and at whose expense.
7	The dealer shall also furnish before sale a written
8	statement identifying any and all defects known to the
9	dealer and any type of damage that the vehicle has
9 10	dealer and any type of damage that the vehicle has sustained if such information is known to the dealer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that any dealer warranties on used ATV's be in writing. It also requires that a dealer when buying an ATV require that the seller certify as to its condition and previous damage history and that this information be furnished to prospective buyers.

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
