Statement of Fact

Currently, basic data relating to expenditures and 3. vacancies, attendance, location and revenues, membership of boards and commissions is not easily accessible, or even known, in many cases. Since state boards and commissions, of which there are more than 200, have a substantial impact upon the State, the State should have basic information about these boards that is easily accessible.

Once the basic information is placed on computer, the annual updating of the 13 14 information will not be a substantial task. 15
