HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 790, L.D. 2078, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand the Membership and Clarify the Role of the Commission on Intergovernmental Relations."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 5th paragraph after the title the following:

'Sec. 7. 3 MRSA §277 is enacted to read:

§277. Staff

Staff to assist the commission in carrying out the functions of section 274 in a timely fashion shall be provided by the office of the Governor.

Staff shall devote such time as may be available prior to the first meeting of the commission to such functions as may be required by law of the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs or, in the absence of a law, as enumerated in Executive Order 5 Fiscal Year 1983-84.'

Further amend the amendment in the 6th paragraph (page 2, line 11 in amendment) by striking out in the first line the following: "'Sec. 7. Work plan." and inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 8. Work plan.'
