The 20 project shall include 7-day-a-week coverage and a sick 21 child area. Selection of the hospital to operate the 22 program shall be made on a request-for-proposal 23 Disproportionate share hospitals, as defined basis. 24 by the Department of Human Services, are not eligible.'

25 Further amend the resolve in that part relating to "Results of this project. Resolved:" by inserting to in the last paragraph in the last line (page 3, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the words "basis; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: "basis. The report shall also contain data on the results of the project including 4 5 the following: Recruitment, retention, absenteeism, productivity and improvement in morale of staff by category of employee, which can be attributed to the 6 7 8 9 provision of the child care service; and whether a 10 more favorable community image and favorable publicity 11 resulted from the provision of the child care service; 12 and be it further'

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Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the last 2 paragraphs before the emergency clause (page 3, lines 3 to 13 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

17 'Funding. That, notwithstanding the Resolved: 18 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 396-C, 19 subsection 2, and section 396-D, the 4th payment-year 20 financial requirements of the hospital selected for the project, for purposes of Title 22, section 396-H, paragraph A, shall include the interim adjustment of \$80,000 to provide a portion of the funds required to 21 22 23 24 support the demonstration project authorized herein. 25 This adjustment shall not be considered part of 26 payment-year financial requirements for purposes of 27 financial computing requirements for subsequent payment years pursuant to Title 22, section 396-C, 28 29 subsection 2.'

30 Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end 31 before the statement of fact the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

resolve authorizes the Maine Health Care 33 This 34 Finance Commission to make an adjustment of \$80,000 in 35 fiscal year 1988-89 to the financial requirements of the hospital selected for the project. 36 No General 37 Fund appropriation is required due to the exclusion of 38 share hospitals from the disproportionate request-for-proposal process. The cost of the project 39 40 will be passed on to all other payors.'
