Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
21-A MRSA §791, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 364, is amended to read:
B. Notwithstanding this subchapter, a candidate who delivers, receives, accepts, notarizes or witnesses an absentee ballot, other than his own absentee ballot, furnished by the clerk of a

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows clerks to process absentee ballots. Public Law 1987, chapter 364, prevents any candidate from handling absentee ballots, including elected clerks.
