1 AN ACT to Increase State Aid for Education in
2 Unrestricted Growth Municipalities.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 20-A MRSA §15612, sub-§3, ¶C is enacted to read:

7 C. When the increase in pupils as set out in
8 paragraph A occurs, and if each municipality

1 within the school administrative unit does not
2 have a moratorium on housing development in
3 effect, the unusual enrollment adjustment
4 authorized in this subsection shall not be less
5 than a 5% increase in the state share of the
6 foundation allocation.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill provides for an increase of at least 5%
9 of the state share of the foundation allocation for
10 education costs in those school administrative units
11 which do not have housing development moratoria and
12 which experience an unusual increase in pupil
13 enrollment.

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
