C. Rest room facilities should have at least one
stall that is not less than 4 feet wide, 5 feet
in depth, a 32-inch wide door that swings out or
slides, handrails on each side mounted 33 inches
from the floor, and a water closet with a seat 20
inches high in conformance with the standard
stall configuration as outlined by the American
National Standards Institute (ANSI A 117.1 - 1986).

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends existing law which mandates the structure of restroom facilities in public accommodations.

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
