1 **AN ACT to Provide that Places of Public**
2 **Accommodation Install Bathroom Stalls in**
3 **Conformance with the American National**
4 **Standards Institute Standards.**

6 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
7 follows:

8 5 **MRSA §4593, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL**
9 1977, c. 80, §1, is further amended to read:

1 C. Rest room facilities should have at least one
2 stall that is not less than 4 feet wide, 5 feet
3 in depth, a 32-inch wide door that swings out or
4 slides, handrails on each side mounted 33 inches
5 from the floor, and a water closet with a seat 20
6 inches high in conformance with the standard
7 stall configuration as outlined by the American
8 National Standards Institute (ANSI A 117.1 - 1986).

9 STATEMENT OF FACT

10 This bill amends existing law which mandates the
11 structure of restroom facilities in public
12 accommodations.
