6 22 MRSA §3174-E is enacted to read:

7 §3174-E. Services for handicapped children



1 Health and Mental Retardation, the Commissioner of  
2 Human Services and the Commissioner of Educational and  
3 Cultural Services to jointly develop a plan which will  
4 maximize the resources available to handicapped  
5 children throughout the State. Specifically, it  
6 mandates the techniques to provide Medicaid  
7 reimbursement in foster home situations which will  
8 provide a preferable level of care at less expense to  
9 the Medicaid program.

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
