10 11 12 13 14	Amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 5th paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the words "that water" and inserting in their place the words 'that hydropower water'
15 16 17 18 19	Further amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 6th paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the words "the water" and inserting in their place the words 'the hydropower water'
20 21 22 23 24	Further amend the bill in the emergency preamble in the 7th paragraph in the 4th line (page 2, line 36 in L.D.) by striking out the words "or water" and inserting in their place the words 'or hydropower water'
25 26 27	Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 3, line 7 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'
28 29 30 31	Further amend the bill in the first paragraph after the amending clause in the 7th to 11th lines (page 3, lines 15 to 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "that no new water diversion projects on or

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affecting the flow regime of these river and stream segments be constructed without the specific authorization of the Legislature" and inserting in its place the following: 'that no new water diversion, which would constitute a hydropower project pursuant to Title 38, section 632, and which would bypass all or part of the natural course of these river and stream segments, be constructed without specific authorization of the Legislature'
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Further amend the bill in the first paragraph after the amending clause in the 6th to 8th lines from the end (page 3, lines 30 to 32 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "for the construction of water diversion projects on or affecting the flow regime of the river and stream segments subject to this special protection" and inserting in its place the following: for the construction of any water diversion project which would constitute a hydropower project pursuant to Title 38, section 632, and which would bypass all or part of the natural course of river and stream segments subject to this special protection without the specific authorization of the Legislature'

Further amend the bill in the 2nd paragraph after the amending clause in the 3rd line (page 3, line 40 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "projects" the following: ', which constitute hydropower projects pursuant to Title 38, section 632,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

30 'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA \$403-A is enacted to read:

31 §403-A. Definitions

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As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

1. Existing dam. "Existing dam" means any man-made barrier across a river segment identified in this chapter which impounds water and has not deteriorated or been breached or modified to the point where it no longer impounds water at 50% or more of its design level at normal flows."

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6 7 8	The intent of this amendment is to limit the application of the new language to water diversions which are part of hydropower projects. It is the intent of the committee that water diversions formed by cofferdams or other devices used for routine and temporary maintenance of existing dams not be affected by the new provisions of this legislation.
9 10	This amendment also provides a definition of the term "existing dam" based on the impoundment level.
