IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

RESOLVE, to Extend the Deadline for the Study of the Relationship between Nonprofit Service Agencies and Professional Liability and Other Hard-to-Obtain Lines of Liability Insurance.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

1 2 3	Whereas, the committee established pursuant to Resolve 1987, chapter 65, requires additional time to complete its study; and
4 5	Whereas, the completion deadline has already passed; and
6 7 8 9 10	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it
12 13 14	Resolve 1987, chapter 65. Resolved: That Resolve 1987, c. 65, 5th ¶ from the end before the emergency clause, is amended to read:
15 16 17 18	Findings. Resolved: That the committee shall report its findings and any recommended legislation to the Legislature by November 15, 1987 February 15, 1988; and be it further
19 20 21	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve extends the reporting deadline for the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance.
