COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 809, L.D. 2118,
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Experience Requirement
for Licensed Dietitians."

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph D, in the
last line (page 3, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "dietetics for a period of 10 years" and
inserting in its place the following: 'as a dietician
without censure for a period of 10 years prior to
September 30, 1987'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment sets a time limit restriction on
the time the dietitians are grandfathered under these
licensure procedures.
