10 Amend the amendment in that part designated 11 "<u>§625</u>." in the first paragraph, by striking out all of 12 the last sentence (page 1, lines 22 to 27 in 13 amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'As part of the no-spray agreement, the public utility shall agree to contribute its avoided cost to municipalities in the amount it would have cost the public utility to maintain that portion of the right-of-way by the use or standard program.'

19 Further amend the amendment in that part 20 designated "<u>§625.</u>" in the 2nd paragraph, in the 2nd 21 line (page 1, line 29 in amendment) by striking out 22 the following: "<u>90</u>" and inserting in its place the 23 following: '<u>180</u>' and in the 5th line from the end 24 (page 2, line 6 in amendment) by striking out the 25 following: "<u>90</u>" and inserting in its place the 26 following: '<u>180</u>'
