IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Concerning Liability for the Cost of Out-of-State Education for Special Needs Students.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

7 20-A MRSA §7201, sub-§2, §C, as enacted by PL 8 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

Page 1-LR3855

C. An exceptional student may be placed in a residential school or institution, or in a private day school or program <u>if the program is approved</u> by the department, or, <u>if the program is out of</u> state, <u>if it is approved</u> by that state's <u>department of education</u>, only after supporting evaluative data justifying the placement have been submitted to and approved by the commissioner.

STATEMENT OF FACT

10 This bill provides that a municipality may send a 11 special education student to an out-of-state school 12 only if that school has been approved by that state's 13 department of education and further approved by the 14 Department of Educational and Cultural Services.
