year the applicant pool va on relative to the number pool varies Each in composition of eligible students attending high-cost private institutions and low-cost public institutions. The financial needs of students change annually. addition, it is Ιn impossible to determine in advance the number of eligible recipients who will change plans and attend school or who will enroll and then drop out for whatever reason. It is also impossible to determine in advance the number of students who will lose awards once given because of transfer to an ineligible school. As a result of these factors, there may be an amount of the funds originally appropriated for the program which will be unused in any given fiscal year.

This bill makes a provision to allow any unused funds to be carried forward to the next year to be used for grants to additional students.
