AN ACT to Modify the Law Regarding the Androscoggin County Budget Committee.

§1451. Purpose

- 13 The purpose of this chapter is to establish in Androscoggin County a method of appropriating money 14 15 for county expenditures, including the salaries 16 county officers, according to a budget which 17 first be adopted by a budget committee and then be approved by the Legislature. This chapter amends the 18 19 present statutory method in sections 2, 252 and 253 by 20 creating a committee elected by Androscoggin County municipal officers with authority to adopt or amend 21 22 budget. The Legislature continues to have 23 or authority to approve but not to amend budget. Notwithstanding section 253, submission of the budget to the Secretary of State is not required. 24

This chapter applies only to Androscoggin County.

29 The At least 120 days before the end of the 30 fiscal year, the county commissioners 31 shall notify all municipal officers in the county 32 to caucus by county commissioner districts least 90 days before the end of the fiscal year at 33 a specified date, time and place for the purpose 34 35 of nominating at least 3 residents of the district 36 of voting age as candidates for the county budget committee. - 8. Interim budget. Until a budget is finally adopted by the Legislature, the county shall operate on an interim budget which may not exceed the previous year's budget. If a final budget is not adopted by May 1st of the fiscal year, until the budget is adopted, the county shall operate on a month-to-month budget which shall not exceed the budget of the same month of the previous year by more than 10%.

§1456. Budget amendments

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The approved budget shall govern the expenditures of the county during the fiscal year.
