HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"  
to S.P. 831, L.D. 2156, Bill, "AN ACT to Make  
Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the  
Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain  
Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper  
Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years  
Ending June 30, 1988, and June 30, 1989."

Amend the amendment in Part A, in section 1, in  
that part designated "LEGISLATURE" in the 3rd line  
(page 91, line 31 in amendment) by striking out the  
figure "\$232,000" and in the blocked paragraph (page  
92, lines 2 to 4 in amendment) by striking out the  
first sentence.

Further amend the amendment in Part A, in section  
1, in that part designated "LEGISLATURE" in the last  
line (page 93, line 36 in amendment) by striking out  
the figure: "\$516,180" and inserting in its place the  
following: '\$284,180'

Further amend the amendment in Part A, in section  
1, in the last line (page 116, line 16 in amendment)  
by striking out the following: "\$78,568,091" and  
inserting in its place the following: '\$78,336,091'

Further amend the amendment in Part KK by striking  
out all of section 1.

1 Further amend the amendment in Part KK by  
2 renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment deletes the references in the  
5 budget to the \$1,500 legislative pay raise. The  
6 purpose of the amendment is to provide that the time  
7 in which a Legislator serves is commensurate with that  
8 person's salary, The consequence of eliminating the  
9 salary increase will be to retain a shortened  
10 legislative session and to forestall a movement  
11 towards a professional Legislature, allowing  
12 succeeding legislative sessions to work towards the  
13 continuation of a citizen's Legislature.
