## 3 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the references in budget to the \$1,500 legislative pay raise. The purpose of the amendment is to provide that the time in which a Legislator serves is commensurate with that 5 6 7 person's salary, The consequence of eliminating the salary increase will be to retain a shortened 8 9 legislative session and to forestall a movement 10 towards a professional Legislature, allowing 11 succeeding legislative sessions to work towards the 12 13 continuation of a citizen's Legislature.
