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STATEMENT OF FACT

The Bangor Children's Dental Clinic, which is available to any Bangor child whose annual household income is at or below the poverty level, requires additional financial support to reduce its growing deficit and to continue to provide quality dental care to indigent children. This bill provides funding for the Bangor Dental Clinic in the same manner as funds were provided to the Chester Dental Clinic in Private and Special Law 1987, chapter 44, section 7.

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
