SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1584, L.D. 2162, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Regulation of Lobster Parts."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6858, sub-§5-B is enacted to read:

5-B. Exception for certain packages. This section shall not apply to canned lobster meat if the person possessing it:

A. Is not the first person offering it for sale in this State and maintains records indicating from whom the lobster meat was purchased; and

B. Did not pack the container or know that it contains lobster meat in violation of subsection 1 or 2.

1 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6862, sub-§5, as reenacted by
2 PL 1985, c. 805, is amended to read:

3 5. Report; repeal. The department shall report
4 in writing to the joint standing committee of the
5 Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources
6 on the activities conducted under this section. The
7 report shall be submitted no later than ~~January 15,~~
8 January 1, 1989. This section is repealed on
9 ~~August 1, 1988~~ March 1, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This amendment limits the application of the
12 exception to canned lobster meat and relocates
13 language to clarify the intent of the bill.


