| 21 22 23 | A. Is not the first person offering it for sale in this State and maintains records indicating from whom the lobster meat was purchased; and |
| 24 25 26 | B. Did not pack the container or know that it contains lobster meat in violation of subsection 1 or 2. |

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1 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA \$6862, sub-\$5, as reenacted by 2 PL 1985, c. 805, is amended to read:

5. <u>Report; repeal.</u> The department shall report in writing to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources on the activities conducted under this section. The report shall be submitted no later than January 157 1968 January 1, 1989. This section is repealed on August-17-1988 March 1, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This amendment limits the application of the 12 exception to canned lobster meat and relocates 13 language to clarify the intent of the bill.
