Statement of Fact

Currently, retailers are held accountable for size restrictions on canned lobster products in their stores and may be penalized for possessing lobster 6 7 parts that they cannot see. This bill exempts retailers from the size restrictions for lobster products, provided that the retailer 9 10 importing, distributing or harvesting lobster.
