SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 832, L.D. 2166, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Status of Police Officers Assigned to the Bureau of Intergovernmental Drug Enforcement and to Add a District Attorney to the Bureau's Policy Board."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 8 the following:

'Sec. 9. 25 MRSA §2955, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

7. Compensation; State Police personnel. Notwithstanding any other provision in this section, Maine State Police officers, senior agents and special investigative agents who are temporarily assigned to the bureau will continue to be paid from the budget of the Bureau of State Police, except that any additional compensation arising from such temporary assignment shall be paid from the budget of the bureau.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

This amendment incorporates the substance of Senate Amendment "A" and makes a technical correction to an allocation to the statutes.


