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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the State is currently experiencing an

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alarming shortage of nursing staff; and

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Whereas, the provisions of low-cost, on-site day care programs at health facilities will create incentive for the recruitment of nursing staff these health care facilities: and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution οf Maine and require the following as immediately necessary legislation for preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

12 Pilot projects. Resolved: That 3 pilot day care projects are established in the northern, central 13 14 and southern parts of the State in 3 separate 15 hospitals.

16 These projects shall provide day care services for 17 health care employees within each designated hospital 18 area.

19 These services shall be available to employees on basis to be 20 sliding fee determined by 21 recipients' incomes; and be if further
