18 The purpose of this bill is to establish four
19 pilot projects for adult literacy programs within the
20 Department of Educational and Cultural Services to
21 enhance adult literacy services.

22 The pilot projects would utilize innovative and
23 previously successful computer training services for
24 teaching basic reading and writing skills for adults
25 requiring literacy services.

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
