1 AN ACT to Provide Challenge Grants for the
2 Development of Municipal and Regional
3 Economic Development Strategies.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13072, sub-§3, ¶¶A, B and C
8 are enacted to read:

1 A. Any municipality, municipal development
2 organization or regional economic development
3 organization which seeks assistance from the
4 department shall be required to have a municipal
5 or regional economic development strategy that is
6 consistent with the provisions of the state
7 strategy.

8 B. Any regional economic or community development
9 strategy shall include policies to promote and
10 facilitate the development of affordable housing
11 for low-income and middle-income persons and
12 policies to manage growth prudently.

13 C. Development grants shall be provided to
14 municipalities and regional economic development
15 organizations on a matching basis, the ratio to be
16 determined by the commissioner according to
17 standards established by rules in accordance with
18 the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, chapter
19 375.

20 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
21 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
22 purposes of this Act.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This bill is a product of a study conducted by the
6 Joint Standing Committee on Economic Development with
7 respect to 14 regional economies located throughout
8 the State. The committee received considerable
9 testimony from municipalities, economic development
10 organizations and individuals which emphasized the
11 need for municipal and regional economic development
12 strategies.

13 This bill proposes that any municipality,
14 municipal development organization or regional
15 economic development organization which obtains any
16 assistance from the Department of Economic and
17 Community Development be required to develop a
18 municipal or regional strategy. This strategy is
19 required to include provisions to promote and
20 facilitate the development of affordable housing for
21 low-income and middle-income households, as well as
22 policies to manage growth prudently.

23 This bill also proposes a \$500,000 appropriation
24 to the Department of Economic and Community
25 Development to be matched with local and regional
26 resources for the creation of those strategies.

27 The purpose of the bill is to determine more
28 precisely the assets and liabilities of a municipality
29 or region and to target resources more effectively to
30 utilize opportunities and resolve problems.

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
