AN ACT to Provide Challenge Grants for the Development of Municipal and Regional Economic Development Strategies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13072, sub-§3, ¶¶A, B and C are enacted to read:
