14	STATEMENT OF FACT
15 16 17 18 19 20 21	This bill provides for payment in lieu of taxes to be made to municipalities in which certain state-owned buildings are located. Payments are made from amounts appropriated by the Legislature on the basis of the share of state-owned building floor space in each municipality. The bill provides \$500,000 in fiscal year 1988-89 for the purpose of state service payments to municipalities.
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
